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PENTA-ID developed in 2012 from the well-established PENTA network, originally a collaboration between paediatric HIV centres in Europe addressing relevant questions in the domain of paediatric HIV. It stems from the need to integrate the expertise acquired by PENTA in more than 20 years of successful activity and the need for new studies in other paediatric infectious diseases.

PENTA-ID has been recognized as a **Level 1 network for Paediatric Infectious Disease in Europe** by European networks of paediatric research at the European Medicines Agency.

Its activities vary from clinical trials, to cohort studies and training. It is currently developing a portfolio of clinical trials in antimicrobials in children including antibiotics, antivirals and antifungals.
